

CHEM 001BH: Honors General Chemistry

CHEM 001BH: Honors General Chemistry is a course designed for students who are interested in pursuing a career in chemistry or a related field. The course covers the fundamental principles of chemistry, including atomic structure, chemical bonding, and stoichiometry. Students will also explore the properties of matter and the laws of thermodynamics. The course is taught by a highly qualified faculty member and includes laboratory work to reinforce the concepts learned in the lecture. Students who complete this course with a grade of C- or better will receive credit for CHEM 001B and will be eligible to enroll in CHEM 002B: Honors General Chemistry II.
